


How to play Phozzle

Phozzle can be played as a classroom or group activity using the IWB, or as a paired or individual activity on tablets. It is perfect for reinforcing children's learning of Phonics Phases 2 to 5 at school or at home by combining phonics with handwriting practice.

Choose a picture to start.



Click once to hear the sound.




Click again to hear the word.



Click again to practise writing.




Neat writing is rewarded with a piece of the jigsaw being removed to reveal the picture.



Here's how to play:

- Choose a picture to start.
- Click on a jigsaw piece to hear the sound of the phoneme or grapheme.
- Click again to hear how it sounds within a word.
- Click again to neatly trace the phoneme or grapheme.
- The jigsaw piece will disappear to reveal part of the picture underneath.
- Repeat this with each jigsaw piece until the whole picture is visible.
- Use the picture as a cue for whole class or paired discussion.
- Don't forget to look for the hidden curly caterpillar in each picture!

Ideas for picture discussion:



What is happening in the picture?

Who are the characters?

What is the weather like? How do you know?

What do you like about the picture?

Imagine you are in the picture, who would you be?

Where would you be?

What are you doing?

Describe where the curly caterpillar is.
